Timeframe	Key Activities – ALPHA calendar (January – December)
Grade 10-11	<ul> <li>Explore options: Attend open days, engage with faculty, and track application and scholarship deadlines.</li> <li>SAT preparation: If required for your tertiary goals, develop and begin a preparation plan. See: Things We've Learned from Our Son's SAT Journey.</li> <li>Academic targets: For local Bachelor's entry, aim for a GPA of 3.5+ with an SAT of 1130 (610 English, 530 Math) or NBT / 2 APs by the end of matric.</li> <li>Stay informed: Monitor changes to Legal &amp; Other Requirements, university, and faculty admission requirements.</li> <li>Community: Share in our Kairos Class of 2026 and Tertiary &amp; Beyond WhatsApp groups.</li> </ul>
October – December (build-up to Senior year)	<ul> <li>Plan your Senior Year: independently or through a Kairos+ Consultation.</li> <li>Familiarise yourself with our Kairos Graduation Request Process.</li> <li>Attend or watch the Kairos Class of 2026 Webinar.</li> <li>15 Oct – 30 Nov: Enrol with Kairos and HLA (Senior fee applies).</li> <li>Dec: Record your Senior Education Plan on myHLA or Kairos will complete this if you use the Kairos+ Applecore Service).</li> <li>Order HLA Senior clothing and rings via the via Blue Eagle Store / Josents).</li> </ul>
January – February	<ul> <li>Begin Gr 12 academics, skills development, and character-building activities.</li> <li>Submit your Senior Shoutout by 1 March.</li> <li>Apply for HLA Scholarships by 1 March.</li> <li>If applicable: Schedule your SAT exam.</li> </ul>
March-May	<ul> <li>Apply feedback from your Gr 12 Kairos+ Transcript Review and HLA Graduation Review (available on myHLA) to your academic planning and execution.</li> <li>Request your official interim HLA transcript on myHLA for local tertiary applications at least 10 business days before you need it, using our Interim Transcript Request Process.</li> <li>Apply to a minimum of three tertiary institutions, jobs, or scholarships (note: most local public universities open 1 April).</li> <li>Monitor your application portals and emails regularly and respond promptly to provisional offers or information requests.</li> </ul>
June	<ul> <li>Before 15 June: Submit your Semester 1 (Spring) report. If the Kairos+ Applecore service has been secured, apply the <u>Semester Reporting Form</u>.</li> <li>Final transcript: You may request your official final HLA transcript after the Spring term if all graduation requirements are met (minimum 22 credits, 6 semesters, and 3+ years). Apply our <u>Graduation Request Process</u>.</li> </ul>
July-15 March (Graduation Window)	<ul> <li>Continue with your Fall (Semester 2) studies. Finish strong!</li> <li>Secure your provisional tertiary admission offers.</li> <li>15 Oct: Earliest possible graduation date if applying the Fall semester only in Gr 12. Apply our Graduation Request Process.</li> <li>Submit your Fall Semester Report (before graduation and 15 March). If the Kairos+ Applecore service has been secured, apply the Semester Reporting Form.</li> <li>Verify that your Applecore information is correct and complete.</li> <li>Request your official HLA Transcript and Diploma through our Graduation Request Process.</li> <li>15 March: Latest possible graduation date to avoid re-enrolment.</li> </ul>
Post- Graduation	<ul> <li>Celebrate your Senior's graduation!</li> <li>Upon receipt of your PDF transcript and diploma (via email), submit copies to tertiary institutions or employers and stay in touch regarding next steps.</li> <li>Use the PDF version to apply to SAQA for your SA NQF Matric Equivalency Letter (recommended for all our matriculants).</li> <li>Safeguard the original hard copy (to be mailed) for future applications.</li> </ul>
